<b>Achillea 'Saucy Seduction'</b>	Delicate, fernlike foliage with flat terminal rose-pink flower heads. Drought tolerant. (yarrow)
Achillea tomentosa 'Nana'	Very dwarf form of yarrow growing less than 6" tall and covered with yellow flowers in summer
<b>Agave a. 'Raea's Gold'</b>	Solid yellow selection of Agave attenuata 'Kara's Stripes' features wide bright yellow succulent leaves.
<b>Agave 'Blue Glow'</b>	This beautiful little gems wide blue green leaves have red margins edged with yellow.
<b>Agave 'Cornelius'</b>	Plant forms an 18" tall by 2.5' wide clump of thick wavy blue-green leaves margined by a 2" wide yellow edge.
<b>Agave f. 'Blue Haze'</b>	This pretty variety of Agave funkiana has lovely powdery-blue leaves with a near-white central midstripe.
<b>Agave 'Kissho Kan'</b>	Blue-gray leaves with creamy-white edges. Spines are a light brown color, changing to burgundy-brown.
<b>Agave p. 'Cream Spike'</b>	This spectacular agave displays blue-green leaves surrounded by a dramatic creamy-white margin.
<b>Agave parryi truncata</b>	Wide blue-gray leaves form a formal, symmetrical rosette. Rounded leaves are with a dark, pointed spike.
<b>Agave 'Porcupine'</b>	This selection of Agave from Yucca Do Nursery features compact green leaves with white leaf edges.
<b>Agave 'Royal Spine'</b>	The thick green leaves have lovely dark spineless margins that end in equally dark terminal spines.
<b>Agave sch. 'Shira ito no Ohi'</b>	Dark-green leaves with a white border, highlighted by silver interior markings.
<b>Agave sch. 'Black Widow'</b>	Displays rigid, dark green leaves with silver marking and interesting filiferous edges.
<b>Agave 'Spagetti Strap'</b>	Has numerous (in excess of 100 when mature) long, narrow-green leaves that are flexible and arch gracefully.
Ajuga 'Black Scallop'	A very crinkled, dark-leaved ajuga for groundcover applications - blue flowers early in the season
<b>Ajuga 'Burgundy Glow'</b>	bright tricolor variegation of burgundy, cream and green; blue flower spikes bloom early spring.
<b>Ajuga 'Dixie Chip'</b>	Violet-blue flower spikes rise above narrow, tricolor green, cream, and burgundy foliage.
Allium senescens 'Glaucum'	Nice border or edging perennial with interesting twisted leaves - pink flowers in Aug.
<b>Allium 'Summer Beauty'</b>	Long blooming with large terminal clusters of lavender-blue flowers, glossy dark green narrow foliage.
Anemone 'Pink Saucer'	One of the earliest blooming anemones - large saucer-shaped pink flowers - 30" tall
<b>Aneonium 'Kiwi'</b>	Temperennial succulent with a kaleidoscope of pinks, oranges, and greens. Pale yellow flowers in. H.6" W.8"
Antennaria neodica - Alba	Silver leaved tiny groundcover growing to 2" tall - white flowers in summer - aka 'pussy toes'
<b>Aptenia cord. var. 'Crystal'</b>	Creeping, hanging succulent; soft, fleshy, cream-edged leaves covered with shiny bubbles of watery fluid.
Aquilega 'Songbird Blue Bird'	Very large 3" upward facing blue flowers on a compact 24" plant - late spring bloom
Aquilegia 'Songbird Cardinal'	Compact growth, very showy red and white flowers with long attractive pink spurs. Height 24-28 inches
Armeria maritima 'Bloodstone'	Longest blooming sea pink - very compact - pink flowers in early summer
Armeria 'Nifty Thrifty'	Low grassy mound of green and white-striped leaves, short stems of bright pink pompon flowers. Ht. 4-6"
Artemisia 'Silver Mound'	Very attractive mound of blue-green foliage - root prune in spring to retain shape
Aruncus aethusifolius	Diminutive form of goats beard only 8" tall - white flowers - nice border plant
Astilbe 'Fanal' (6-8)	Early blooming cultivar with attractive bronze foliage and dark, blood-red flowers - 20" tall
Astilbe 'Rhythm & Blues'	Mid-season flowers are bright salmon-pink and are held above dark green compact foliage - 18" tall
Astilbe 'Visions'	Raspberry-red plumes on compact 14 to 16" coarse-textured foliage - moist soil
Astilbe 'Visions in Red'	Similar to above but with purplish-red plumes during mid-season up to 18" tall
Astilbe 'Weisse Gloria'	Very full, stocky white plumes blooming in mid -summer - 24" tall - prefers part shade and moist conditions
Berberis 'Concorde'	Improvement over 'Crimson Pygmy' Dwarf red leaved barberry - very showy
<b>Berberis 'Gold Beret'</b>	Bright golden foliage throughout the season - great foliar plant
Bergenia cord. 'Winterglut'	Shiny, evergreen, cabbage-like leaves with unique leathery appearance - red flowers in spring
Brunnera mac. 'Looking Glass'	2004 introduction - sport of 'Jack Frost' having silver over the entire leaf
Brunnera mac. 'Jack Frost'	Outstanding foliage plant - unique patterned leaves - blue flowers early summer
Brunnera mac. 'Kings Ransom'	New silver and gold sport of "Jack Frost" - cream yellow margins turn white later in the season - 12" tall
Brunnera 'Variegata'	Green and white attractive foliage with tiny blue flowers during early summer
<b>Calla 'Black Star'</b>	Very dark purple almost black flowers contrast nicely with white mottled leaves, large 3-4" flowers.
Calla 'Golden Chalice'	Spectacular large golden-yellow flowers - compact slightly spotted foliage - 18" tall - dig bulbs for the winter
Calla 'Lipstick'	Tender bulbs - intense hot pink flowers on green foliage - very floriferous - dig and store for the winter
Calla 'Picasso'	Beautiful and unique creamy white flowers with deep purple centers and mottled foliage - dig for the winter
Campanula 'Birch Hybrid'	Compact blue bellflower excellent for the border or rock garden applications
Campanula 'Blue Clips'	Compact mounds of light green foliage with upward facing cup-shaped blue flowers - 6" tall
Campanula 'Blue Waterfall'	Vigorous low growing habit with sprays of stary lavender blue flowers most of the summer - 8" tall
Campanula car. 'Clips White'	Compact foliage to 8" with white bell shaped flowers during most of the summer
Campanula 'Dickson's Gold'	Very dense and compact- bright gold foliage- profusion of lavender blue, star shaped flowers. HT. 4"-6"
Campanula 'Light Blue Clips'	Compact foliage to 6" with light blue bell-shaped flowers blooming most of the summer
Campanula 'Pearl Deep Blue'	Compact mounds with 2" upward facing violet-blue flowers - more ht tolerant & earlier bloom than Blue Clips
<b>Centaurea 'Amethyst Dream'</b>	Compact and well branched clumps, unique very deep purple flowers, long bloom time.
Centaurea 'Amethyst in Snow'	Compact and well branched clumps-large flower buds with pure white petals open to purple centers. Ht. 14"
Centaurea 'Gold Bullion'	Chartreuse leaves with blue flowers on 12" to 15" stems - blooms in mid-summer
<b>Cham. L. 'Amaize N' Blue'</b>	Blue-green juvenile foliage that turns an attractive gold in autumn. Compact, upright, pyramidal plant.
<b>Cham. Laws. 'Oregon Blue'</b>	A narrow columnar with attractive blue foliage that gracefully droops at the tips. Strong growing
<b>Cham. Obt. 'Blue Feathers'</b>	A dense, compact evergreen with feathery, juvenile foliage. Branches twist upward to expose blue underside.
<b>Cham. Obt. 'Verdoni'</b>	Hinknoi cypress with dark green leaves with gold margins - slow growing - needs winter protection
<b>Cham. Pis. 'Soft Serve'</b>	A compact, conical Chamaecyparis with graceful, fern-like branching. Bright green leaves.
<b>Cham. Pis. 'Vintage Gold'</b>	A strong growing golden mound. Fern-like foliage is soft and attractive. Bright yellow foliage all season.
Cham. Mini Variegated'	A dwarf round globe with gray green foliage dotted with creamy white variegation
Cim. 'Hillside Black Beauty'	The darkest purple-black foilage to date- foot long bottle brush flowers are white with pale-pink stems. Ht 54"
Cimicifuga 'Chocoholic'	New Release- Half the size of Hillside Black Beauty with the same purple-black foliage Ht. 2-3ft
Clematis 'Ernest Markham'	Magenta red flowers have a velvety sheen and golden anthers - vigorous grower - later blooming cultivar
Clematis 'Fireworks'	Large flowered bicolor cultivar - bright purple flowers with a wide, vivid reddish-pink central bar

Clematis 'Jackmanii'	Vigorous blue flowering vine to 10' - needs cool alkaline soil conditions
Clematis 'Malaya Garnet'	Very pale-pink flowers with a bright crimson bar- pink-tipped, cream filaments rest in center of flower. Ht. 6ft
Clematis 'Red Cardinal'	Glowing crimson-red flowers with blunt tipped, recurving sepals and contrasting cream anthers. 6" flower
<b>Coreopsis 'Cosmic Eye'</b>	Bicolor flowers of burgundy-red with bright yellow tips and golden yellow centers.
Coreopsis 'Zagreb'	Similar to 'Moonbeam but with darker yellow flowers and a more compact growth habit
Cotoneaster 'Tom Thumb'	A low cushion forming plant with glossy dark green leaves - pink flowers and red fruit - only 4" tall
Crococsmia 'Lucifer'	ZONE 5 - Gladiola type foliage with brilliant red flowers in late summer - mulch
<b>Delosp. sphalmanthoides</b>	Tiny, finger-like leaves grow in tight mat that is smothered with fuchsia flowers in very early spring.
Delosperma 'Table Mountain'	Blooms all summer - fuchsia colored flowers cover the 2" high foliage - ZONE 5 - treat as an annual
<b>Delph. 'Moonlight Blues'</b>	Short with stout flower spikes that comprise half the height. Sky-blue flowers with a hint of pink. 2.5-3'
Delphinium 'Morning Lights'	A compact grower from the Millennium Series only 3' tall - lavender-pink flowers/white bee
Delphinium 'Pagan Purples'	Dramatic spires of very dark bluish-purple flowers with a white or brown bee-often double flowered 5ft
Delphinium 'Pink Punch'	Strong, broad spikes of rich mulberry pink, often frilled flowers with a white or pink stripe bee. 3-5ft
Dianthus 'Apple Slice'	Glaucous blue-green 10" plant with red flowers covered with pale pink blotches
<b>Dianthus 'Fire Star'</b>	Slightly bushier mounds of gray-green foliage, bright fiery red flowers with dark crimson centers, very fragrant
Dianthus grant. 'Firewitch'	Excellent groundcover with blue green leaves and pink flowers which have a long bloom
Dianthus 'Neon Star'	Tight 7" mounds of blue-gray foliage - heavy bloom during cooler weather - very bright pink flowers
Dianthus 'Pomegranate Kiss'	Velvety red fragrant double flowers that are splashed and streaked with rose pink-blue green grassy foliage
Dianthus 'Raspberry Swirl'	Young flowers have pink petals with a maroon picotee edge-Loosely, mounded gray-green foliage. Ht 7"
Dianthus 'Spangled Star'	Petals are scarlet-red with pale pink serrated edges - foliage is blue green and very compact
Dicentra 'Burning Hearts'	New Release- Clusters of valentine red heart-shaped flowers, very finely cut blue-gray foliage. Ht. 10"
<b>Dicentra 'Ivory Hearts'</b>	Large white heart-shaped flowers held in clusters above finely cut blue-gray foliage, continuous rebloom.
Dicentra 'King of Hearts'	Very compact blue-grey foliage carrying pinkish-red flowers through the summer
Dicentra 'Luxuriant' (2-3)	12" ever blooming bleeding heart with pink flowers on blue-green foliage
<b>Dictamnus albus</b>	Gas plant- spikes of unique, white, aromatic flowers in June. Very slow growing. H 2', W 2' Zone 3
<b>Dictamnus albus 'Purpureus'</b>	Gas plant- Dark veined, pink flowers. Long lived flowers. H 30", W 24" Zone 3
<b>Draba aizoides</b>	Green cushions topped off with hot yellow flowers in early spring. Needs well drained soil. Great for troughs
<b>Echeveria 'The Rose'</b>	Thick, sculptured leaves form a metallic, ruffled, 'Rose Blossom' up to 6" in diameter. H.10" W.15"
Echinacea 'After Midnight'	Distinctive dwarf selection - fragrant, dark magenta purple flowers and a black cone - only 12" tall
Echinacea 'Fatal Attraction'	Vivid purple-pink flowers with 2 rows of perky petals atop dark red to near black stems. Ht. 26"
Echinacea 'Green Jewel'	Produces large green cone surrounded by lighter green gray petals, fragrant and compact. Ht. 24"
Echinacea 'Mac & Cheese'	New Release- Bright yellow, well-branched, vigorous. Ht. 26"
Echinacea 'Pink Poodle'	New Release- Large fluffy double pink flowers, good branching Ht. 32"
Echinacea 'Sunrise'	Single daisy-like flowers are citron yellow with a central cone that turns from green to gold with time
<b>Echin. 'Tangerine Dream'</b>	Elegant 4" clear orange flowers have wide, overlapping petals. The bloom holds its color better than any other.
Echinacea 'Twilight'	Deep rose-pink petals with a large burgundy-red button-shaped cone. Blooms are fragrant. Ht. 24-30"
<b>Echinacea 'Vintage Wine'</b>	Dark raspberry-red flowers, very strong stems, and huge orange cones, sturdy with dark green foliage.
Echinacea 'White Swan'	Heavy blooming plant with white flowers and a copper cone - grows to about 20" tall
Epimedium rubrum	Lilac-rose flowers blooming very early on compact 12" plants - best in semi to full shade
Euphorbia 'Bon Fire'	Exciting new perennial cultivar in high demand - very dark foliage with golden flowers in Late May
Euphorbia 'First Blush'	Yellow bracts in early summer above white, pink & green foliage
Euphorbia polychroma	Intense golden yellow bracts color up in late May - long lived perennial - 12" tall
<b>Fern adiantum pedatum</b>	Very graceful fern, delicate fan-shaped green fronds are a nice contrast to their black wiry stems.
Fern athyrium 'Frizelliae'	Sport of the popular Lady Fern with very narrow and scalloped fronds - very unique - moist cool conditions
Fern athyrium 'Ghost'	Very similar to the 'Bradford Beauty' fern - cross between the lady Fern and the Japanese Painted Fern
Fern athyrium nip. 'Pictum'	Japanese painted fern - outstanding combination of burgundy and silver foliage
<b>Fern athyrium 'Red Beauty'</b>	Silver and burgundy variegated fronds similar to Metallicum accented with bright red stems.
<b>Fern athyrium 'Victoriae'</b>	Unique narrow leaflets that are crested at the ends, very unusual and sure to generate conversation.
Gaillardia 'Arizona Sun'	Compact and uniform plant with large fiery orange-red blooms flamed with yellow edges-floriferous Ht. 10"
Gaillardia 'Fanfare'	Very showy compact Gaillardia-scarlet flowers with bright yellow tips-long blooming. Ht. 18-24"
<b>Gaultheria procumbens</b>	Evergreen foliage with bright red edible berries, bright burgundy fall color, ground color for shady gardens.
<b>Gaura 'Siskiyou Pink'</b>	Wand Flower- Pink flowers, rigid wiry stems, long flowering. 18"
<b>Gentian 'True Blue'</b>	Upright clump forming with smooth lance-shaped leaves, clusters of large 2" tubular blue flowers.
<b>Geranium 'Ballerina'</b>	Low-growing mounding geranium with deeply divided foliage, lilac-pink flowers with a dark eye.
Geranium cat. 'Karmina'	Dwarf growing border geranium with raspberry pink flowers - long bloom season
<b>Geranium 'Katherine Adele'</b>	Deeply divided green foliage accented with burgundy splotches between the veins. Large light-pink flowers.
Geranium 'Dark Reiter'	Deeply divided dark reddish-plum , leaves, lilac blue flowers- grows best in cooler moist areas. Ht. 10"
Geranium s. var. Striatum	Very low-growing and easy to grow. Gorgeous shell pink flowers with dark crimson veins. Ht. 6"
Geranium sang. 'Max Frei'	Compact dark green foliage to 6" tall - deep magenta flowers bloom most of the summer
Geranium sub. 'Splendens'	Low growing compact mounded foliage produces bright magenta flowers with black veins & a black eye
Geum 'Borisii'	Semi-double, upward facing, bright magenta-orange flowers with yellow anthers - bloom late spring - 12" tall
grass Cal. 'Avalanche'	Hardy grass to 4' tall - green blades have an attractive white stripe down the center - upright clumping
grass Cal. 'Eldorado'	Similar to Calamagrostis 'Avalanche' but with a gold stripe down the center of the blade
Grass Cal. 'Overdam'	Very hardy excellent northern grass - narrow white strip on blade margins - to 48" tall
<b>Grass Carex 'Bonzita'</b>	brown-leaved grass has narrow, slender, arching leaves growing in a dense mound that is upright.
Grass Carex musk. 'Oehme'	Attractive variegated palm edge - has high moisture requirements but is very hardy for our area - 24" tall
grass koeleria glauca 'Coolio'	Low mound of fine blue-green leaves with a hedgehog appearance. Tall stems of greenish flowers Ht. 12"
Grass Miscanthus 'Gold Bar'	Outstanding new introduction only 18" tall - showy horizontal creamy bands appear in early spring

<b>Grass Penn. 'Little Bunny'</b>	Dwarf form with short tufts of green leaves and miniature tan bottlebrush flowers in mid-summer.
<b>Helleborus 'Ivory Prince'</b>	Burgundy-pink buds open to outward facing, ivory blossoms streaked with rose and chartreuse.
Hem. 'Ain't I Something'	Very large yellow double with a green throat Dip - SEV - M - 36" - 7"
Hem. 'All American Chief'	Bright velvet red flowers with a yellow throat Tet - Dor - ML - 32" - 10"
Hem. 'Andrew Christian'	Bright lemon-yellow self with a green throat Tet - SEV - M - 30" - 5"
Hem. 'Angels in Disguise'	Lavender-pink with deep sculptured throat Tet - Dor - E - 25" - 6"
Hem. 'Atlanta Full House'	Yellow self - green throat - thick substance Tet - Dor - M - 27" - 6.5"
Hemerocallis 'Bird Bath Pink'	Pink self with a large cream to green throat Tet - EV - M - 26" - 7"
Hem. 'Betty Warren Woods'	Cream-yellow with darker gold ruffled edge Tet - EV - EM - 24" - 4.5"
Hem. 'Blueberry Cream Swirl'	Light cream with dark violet veins - blue violet eye Tet - SEV - EM - 26" - 7"
Hem. 'Broadway Smile'	Deep pink bitone with a yellow watermark Tet - Dor - M - 16" - 3"
Hemerocallis 'Brooklyn Twist'	Violet red spider with a prominent green throat Tet - SEV - M - 28" - 9"
Hem. 'Cameroon Night'	Dark purple self with a green throat Tet - SEV - EM - 36" - 7.5"
Hem. 'Camerons Twister'	Wine purple flowers with a light purple watermark Tet - Dor - ML - 40" - 7.5"
H 'Caribbean Whipped Cream'	Cream yellow blend with green throat. Dip-Dor-EM-19"- 5.5"
Hemerocallis 'Cast A Spell'	Purple with a white picotee edge Dip - SEV - EM - 22" - 5"
Hem. 'Cheddar Cheese'	Brilliant orange-gold self with a green a throat Tet - Dor - EM - 30" - 5.5"
Hemerocallis 'Cherokee Pass'	Gold with a red eye zone and picotee edge Tet - Dor - ML - 32" - 5.5"
Hem. 'Cosmic Questions'	Rolled back melon self with a green throat Dip - SEV - M - 20" - 5.5"
Hem. 'Cute as a Button'	Cream colored double miniature Dip - SEV - E - 15" - 2"
Hem. 'Cute as Can Be'	Red colored double miniature Dip - SEV - EM - 12" - 2"
Hem. 'Darlington Country'	Rose self with a green throat Tet - Dor - E - 24" - 6"
Hem. 'Destined to See'	Cream yellow with a lavender eye and edge Tet - EV - EM - 24" - 6"
Hemerocallis 'Double Booked'	Apricot polychrome with a orange throat Dip - Dor - M - 20" - 4.5"
Hemerocallis 'Dream Lover'	Rose-pink self with a lime-green throat Tet - SEV - M - 34" - 5.5"
Hemerocallis 'Duke of Earl'	Deep ruby self with an emerald-green throat Tet - Dor - M - 30" - 5"
Hemerocallis 'Elegant Candy'	Fragrant pink blooms with a red eye Tet - Dor - EM - 25" - 4.5"
Hem. 'Faces of a Clown'	Yellow with an etched red eye and green throat Tet - SEV - EM - 26" - 6"
Hemerocallis 'Fire Engine'	Bright red with a darker red eye and green throat Tet - Dor - L - 34" - 5.5"
Hem. 'Forsythe Klondike'	Thick substance gold flowers with a green throat Tet - Dor - ML - 30" - 7.5"
Hemerocallis 'Ginger Twist'	Pink-orange with red band above green throat Tet - Dor - M - 29" - 11"
Hemerocallis 'Golden Sentry'	Deep gold self with a green throat - thick substance Tet - Dor - EM - 38" - 6.5"
Hemerocallis 'Guapa'	Large rose-pink self with a green throat Tet - Dor - M - 28" - 7"
Hemerocallis 'Heart Pumping'	Very large apricot blend with a red halo Tet - SEV - M - 34" - 8"
Hemerocallis 'Isosceles'	Bright yellow flat flowers with a green throat Tet - Dor - ML - 23" - 6.5"
Hemerocallis 'Janet Benz'	Strawberry-rose with a gold edge and green throat Tet - Dor - M - 28" - 5.5"
Hemerocallis 'Blue Flirt'	Very unique mauve colored with a pencil line of blue Dip - SEV - EM - 18" - 3"
Hem. 'Little Show Stopper'	Double miniature with rose-red flowers Dip - SEV - EM - 20" - 2.5"
Hemerocallis 'Lord of Rings'	Purple blend with a creamy yellow-green throat Tet - SEV - M - 28" - 5.5"
Hemerocallis 'Lux Hybrid'	Popular Rose-Hill Hybrids - salmon pink flowers with a narrow ruffled gold edge around the petals
Hemerocallis 'Majestic Move'	Yellow pink blend with a green throat - thick substance Tet -Dor- M - 28" - 6"
Hemerocallis 'Mal'	Large cream-white blend with a green throat Tet - EV - M - 30" - 7.5"
Hemerocallis 'Mary's Gold'	Deep gold self with thick substance Tet - Dor - L - 34" - 6.5"
